Her curiosity and passion in art led her to leave that permanent job with a promising career in advertising to be seriously focus in arts. She continued her studies in Visual Art in 2014 and gained her Master of Fine Art Degree, graduated *Cum Laude* from Faculty of Art and Design, Institut Teknologi Bandung in 2016.
